## Gliosarcoma with thallium-201 SPECT

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Thallium-201 (<sup>201</sup>Tl) chloride scintigraphy is the imaging method use for the detection of various tumors including glioblastoma, but only limited information on <sup>201</sup>Tl uptake in gliosarcoma is available. We investigated a patient with gliosarcoma by means of <sup>201</sup>Tl single-photon emission computed tomography (SPECT) and MRI. SPECT imaging revealed high <sup>201</sup>Tl uptake in the tumor, which was closely correlated with contrast-enhancement on MRI. These results suggest that SPECT with <sup>201</sup>Tl may be useful for detecting gliosarcoma and provide physiological information on this tumor.
