Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Research work should be original and innovative

2. There is no fee for submitting an abstract

3. There is no limit to the number of abstracts you may submit (however

an individual may not be offered more than 2 oral presentations)

Abstract Content

1. Abstracts will be accepted in English only (Please carefully proofread

to ensure accuracy of published material. The Committee reserves the

right to reject abstracts submitted in poor English, or may request an

immediate revision by the author)

2. Abstracts must not exceed 500 words in length (not including title and

authors)

3. Title must not exceed 30 words

4. Capitalize the first letter of each word except prepositions, articles and

species names on the title.

5. Do not include company's name and trademark-registered software and

equipment in the title.

6. Abstract should be TEXT ONLY. Do not include Tables, Figures, and

Graphs

Abstract Structure

1. Title and Authors

2. Background – Specification on the purposes of research

3. Methods – brief description of relevant experimental procedures

4. Results – Summary of the results

5. Conclusions – Concluding statements and implications of study

6. Keywords – List more than 3 keywords to distinguish the abstract for

indexing purposes

Authors

1. The presenting author of an accepted abstract must be confirmed and

registered by March 18, 2016

Rising NM Professional Challenge

1) Candidate must be Nuclear Medicine Professional under the age of 45

2) Abstracts submitted for Rising NM Professional Challenge will be

reviewed by the Scientific Committee and will be judged solely on the

data submitted. The final decision on the candidates lies at the sole

discretion of the Scientific Committee (One per participating

region/country)

3) Candidates will present to a panel of judges within a ten (10) minute

timeframe

4) Topic of presentation must be derive from the following four (4) fields

of Nuclear Medicine:

a) Basic Science Research of Nuclear Medicine

b) Clinical Research of Nuclear Medicine

c) Nuclear Medicine Imaging

d) Nuclear Medicine Therapy

5) Candidates selected for the Rising NM Professional Challenge will be

awarded with \$500USD to support and promote the development of

young Nuclear Medicine Professionals.
