The 1st WFNMB in 1974

From September 30 to October 4 in **Tokyo** and on October 5 in **Kyoto**. Then-Crown Prince Naruhito (the present Emperor) and then-Princess Michiko (the present Empress) at the opening ceremony in Tokyo.

Since 1964, the JSNM has kept on collaborating worldwide with the SNMMI, the EANM, the WFNMB and the IAEA as well as regionally with the AOFNMB (Asia Oceania Federation of Nuclear Medicine and Biology), the ARCCNM (Asian Regional Cooperative Council for Nuclear Medicine) and the ANMB (Asian Nuclear Medicine Board).

- The 13th ARCCNM and the 1st ANMB Exam was held in Osaka in November 2014.
- The 12th AOFNMB will be held in Yokohama, Japan in October 5-8 2017.
